## RV-7, RV-9, Seatback Storage Tray Installation



When installed, the tray should look like this.




Note: Leave the 3M Dual Lock attached to itself during installation. For installation, only remove the backside adhesive protection.

1) Recommend to install tray ¼ inch from the center post position in order to have room at the opposite outboard edge to fit hand to remove when needed.




Note: Leave the 3M Dual Lock attached to itself during installation. For installation, only remove the backside adhesive protection.

- 2) Cut the outboard 3M Dual Lock to the desire length. It is beneficial to leave some additional 3M Dual Lock extending from the <u>outboard edge</u> in order to be able to pull with hand or pliers to ease removal, but it not required if not desired.
- 3) Cut the inboard 3M Dual Lock (at the center post) flush with the tray.



Note: Leave the 3M Dual Lock attached to itself during installation. For installation, only remove the backside adhesive protection.

4) Clean seatback rail to ensure good adhesion.



- 5) Secure storage tray to seatback rail making sure the storage <u>tray groove sits on the rail lower 90 bend for good support</u>.
- 6) When the tray is in place, apply hand pressure to the adhesive by pressing on the tray upper flange to make good contact.
